Due to low attendance, group decided to table accepting minutes until next meeting.

Jenny has been in touch with Health Department Nurse Gemma to let her know Chebeague is interested in a vaccine clinic for booster when Moderna booster is available.

Discussion about having a vaccine clinic for children. We may not have enough 5-12 year olds to have our own clinic.

Eliza - KN95 masks have been available at Town Office, Rec Center, Library, but demand has been low.

Melissa - doesn't seem to be anything else urgent to discuss.

Eliza - we need to plan for extended power outages in cold weather while addressing gathering of groups seeking heat, facilities, and food.

Parish House is a possibility, Hall is not, Rec Center has no generator.

Melissa and Jenny are willing to have a conversation with the Hall Committee relative to emergency space during power outages. The Hall/Library have heat pumps and HEPA filters.

Justin: Larger towns have set emergency plans, small communities like ours have no adopted plans.

Jenny is concerned about elders who might be alone in their homes without heat, power, plumbing. Perhaps there can be a phone tree.

Eliza - have text alert go out in advance of predicted storms. Also had very enthusiastic and positive comments relative to the Kids Place.

Melissa - Kids Place has been a wonderful, safe place since the start.

Jenny - wants everyone to be mindful of Covid-19 precautions while starting up social opportunities.

Melissa- Food Pantry will not function as it did last year. Folks will be able to sign up for food boxes once a month; food insecurity will always be addressed; those not able to leave the Island to shop will be given assistance with different methods of ordering remotely and working with John Wilkinson who picks up orders and delivers to boat.
