

NOTES: FY 2016 CAPITAL ASSET INVENTORY

ADMINISTRATION

- **Building:** North Road building; town offices, fire & rescue barn
- **Building – Roof:** North Road building roof
- **Building – Septic:** North Road building septic system
- **Large Plant Generator:** North Road building automatic generator
- **Land Acquisition/Development:** (new, proposed) catch-all asset category to hold reserves for town land acquisition, easement purchases, development, engineering expenditures (e.g., studies/work/legal expenses for parking lot development)
- **Small Pickup Truck (green):** existing crew-cab vehicle used for transporting town employees
- **Utility Pickup Truck (shared, Public Services):** (new, proposed) standard size crew cab vehicle to be available for use by town employees, but reside with Public services for use instead of the larger, more costly, more fuel-intensive trucks
- **SUV (white):** existing vehicle for transporting town employees, to be retained and used as long as it continues to run (not a lot longer)
- **Grant Match Funds:** provides matching funds for grants for work, studies, or research performed by the town
- **Paper Streets:** to fund costs of conversion of paper streets into town streets
- **Revaluation Funds:** 3 year town-wide revaluation process, nearing completion
- **Coastal Access Funds:** to fund projects that enable public coastal access
- **Cemetery General Fund:** administrative fee funded, this is the cemetery's capital reserve for capital maintenance projects
- **Cousins Island Parking Reserve:** provides for roadway and parking lot capital improvements and repairs at the Cousins Island lot

MARINE

- **Stone Wharf/Wave Break:** reserves to cover capital repairs/changes to the island's main transportation hub, vital to passengers, fishermen, & freight
- **Stone Wharf Dredging:** reserves for periodic dredging to maintain good water access to Stone Wharf
- **Stone Wharf Aluminum Ramp:** reserve for replacement of ramp which provides access to CTC float
- **Stone Wharf Aluminum Ramp (backup):** backup Stone Wharf ramp; on land at Town Garage
- **Stone Wharf CTC Float 12 X 30:** CTC lands at this float
- **Stone Wharf CTC Float (backup):** can serve as emergency backup to float at Stone Wharf; on land at Town Garage
- **Stone Wharf Punt Floats 10 X 25 (7):** recreational/commuter usage for small craft

- **Cousins Island CTC Float 12 X 30 (or bigger, now?):** CTC's mainland access float, punt tie-up also
- **Floats, Chandler's 10 X 20 (3):** used by fishermen, recreational boaters, water taxi
- **Aluminum Ramp, Chandler's:** access to floats from Chandler's Wharf
- **Stone Wharf Boat Ramp:** CTC barge lands here, other commercial barging
- **Barge Ramp – Bennett's:** large commercial barge access from Portland
- **Harbormaster Skiff & Motor:** access to boat on mooring, patrol flats
- **Parker 23':** harbormaster vessel (for now)
- **225 hp Outboard:** powers the harbormaster vessel

PUBLIC SAFETY

- **2007 Fire Engine 4:**

- **1985 Fire Engine 1 (tanker):**
- **Hydraulic Extrication Tool:** jaws of life-type equipment
- **Air Bags, Car Lift:** levitates vehicles to extricate victims
- **Thermal Imaging Camera:** can see through smoke to locate fire victims
- **Air Compressor System:** in-house air bottle recharger
- **120' Communications Tower:** to be constructed at North Road site to support radio transmissions/dispatch equipment
- **Radio/Repeater Antenna System:** equipment on mainland (dispatch and Back Towers), Long Island, and Chebeague that provides for transmission and reception of emergency dispatch signals.
- **2003 Ambulance:** medical rescue services
- **Defibrillator/EKG monitor:** defibrillates and/or monitors patients' vital signs in ambulance
- **Stretcher:** transfers patients from island to mainland rescue services
- **Fire Pond Dredging:** ponds located around the island provide access to fresh water for firefighting purposes

PUBLIC SERVICES

- **1986 GMC Boom Truck:** can lift floats from water, although those are trailered now; other occasional uses, plan is to own until it no longer works
- **#6 2000 Dump Truck (white):** road plowing, heavy hauling
- **#3 2003 Dump Truck (red):** general Public Services work, roads & other
- **#4 1981 Dump Truck (green):** hauls heavy loads
- **Blade Plow:** snow plowing
- **Utility Pick-up (shared with Admin):** general use, replacing daily use of 2003 dump truck, save wear & tear
- **Case Excavator (proposed):** ditching, brush dump, transfer station, gravel and general excavation work
- **Backhoe/Loader:** ditching etc.

- **Small Grader:** grades and maintains gravel/dirt roads
- **Bulldozer:** moving earth & stone, primarily at Town Garage
- **4wd Ford Backhoe (trade-in):** engine blown, can be traded for excavator
- **Chipper:** chips small to moderate brush at brush dump
- **3,000 Gallon Skid Tank:** fuel storage
- **Town Garage:** houses Public Services equipment, office
- **Town Garage – Septic:** septic treatment at Town Garage
- **Town Garage Salt Shed:** sheltered storage for road salt/sand
- **Transfer Station Building:** shelters recycling operations
- **Transfer Station – Compactor 1:** trash compacting
- **Transfer Station – Compactor 2:** trash compacting
- **Transfer Station – Compactor 3:** trash compacting
- **Paving:** capital maintenance of island's roadways and parking surfaces
- **Easements & Drainage Ways:** capital maintenance providing for proper drainage of island road surfaces

SCHOOL

- **School Bus:** transports island students
- **Roof:** school building roof
- **Doors:** school building access/egress
- **Windows:** light and air for school building
