Transmission and Brake Fluids	Battery Acid and Muriatic Acid
Turpentine / Varnish / Stains	Waste Oil / Gasoline / Diesel
Paint Remover & Strippers / Thinners	Linseed Oil
Pool and Photo Chemicals	Rechargeable Batteries
Used Antifreeze / Driveway Sealer	Fever and Cooking Thermometers
Adhesives / Solvents	PCB Ballasts
Oven and Drain Cleaners

### **Accepted Materials Include:**

Refrigerators / freezers (A \$25 fee applies, DOORS MUST BE REMOVED)  
Air Conditioners (A \$25 fee applies)  
Lamps: high-pressure sodium and fluorescent, neon, mercury vapor, and metal halide

Bulky furniture	Mercury containing devices
TV's	Hot water tanks
Computer monitors and CPU's	20 pound gas tanks
Printers, scanners, copiers	Tires (NO attached rims)
Plumbing fixtures	Scrap metal
Weather barometers	Non-Freon appliances
Blood pressure cuffs	

**During the special collections, traffic must enter through the transfer station from North Rd. and must exit at the Public Works Garage on Littlefield Rd.**

**During the special collections the brush dump will be open.**

**During the special collections regular household waste and recycling will be accepted for disposal at the Transfer Station compactors.**

**Construction and demolition debris will not be accepted as part of either special collection but will be accepted for regular disposal. Regular fees will apply.**
