MONTHLY REPORT

December 2022

Started the month off with a wind storm and spent the day out clearing trees and debris off the roads and out of the ditches with the backhoe. Put back cleats on the ramps at stone pier and Cousins and added sand paper strips to give them better grip because CTC was complaining that when they were wet they were slippery. We put out the red and green snow road markers at Stone wharf. Started the boom truck and got the town punt and the rest of the equipment ready to pull the floats. Had fuel delivered to the island for the town vehicles. We pulled and removed 4 floats out of 8. Flushed outboard and rinsed down trailer and truck of salt water. Took pictures of damage at Chandlers Dock and sent to TA to forward to the state to be fixed. Had a snow and ice storm that we took care of. We had to replace a belt on our blower for our heating system. Welded light protector back together on truck ten and made improvements to it. Did some maintenance on truck 4 for the fire dep. Had major wind and rain storm witch I worked with CMP to lift trees off power lines and pushed about 20 trees off the roads. Worked with Lucas tree closing roads and pushing tree debris off the roads when they were done. Fixed all three chains at Chandlers dock floats with new chain and rollers and did inspection of floats witch I found them to be in good shape with a little TLC to some of the tie up boards. I also found that one of the ropes from the dock to the floats were pulling the end of the float down a little. I will follow up working on ropes and tie up maintenance on floats early this spring when weather and time allow. And finally drove around island after major storm to get GPS coordinates and pictures to help with storm reimbursement statement.
